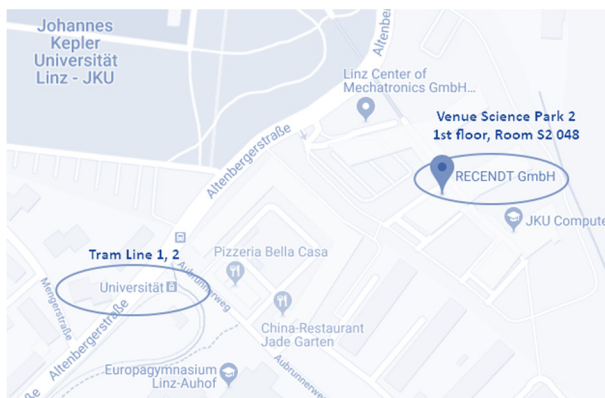

## Travel information

### Travel by plane:

The **Blue Danube Airport of Linz** is located few kilometres outside the city and offers connections to Berlin, Düsseldorf, Frankfurt, London Stansted, and Vienna. There is a bus connection to the main station in Linz (Linz/Donau Hbf). Alternatively, one can take a taxi towards to Linz city centre, which costs around 35€. <http://www.linz-airport.com/en>

The next largest airport within close distance is the **Vienna International Airport**. There is a direct train connection from the Vienna airport to Linz main station. The train takes about two hours from Vienna to Linz and departs approx. two times an hour (see ÖBB Website <https://www.oebb.at/en/>). Additionally, there is a bus/train connection from the airport to the main station in Vienna (Wien Hauptbahnhof). <https://www.viennaairport.com/en/passengers>

Alternatively you can go to **Munich Airport** and take the train to Linz from there or take an airport shuttle bus to Linz. <https://www.munich-airport.com/passengers-visitors-75328>

### Travel by tram/bus:

The city centre is very well connected with several tram and bus lines. Nevertheless, in order for you to reach the venue, it is highly convenient to take the tram Line 1 or 2 in direction "Universität". Get off at the last station "Universität" and from there it's only a two Minutes' walk to reach the venue.

### Travel by car:

The motorway A1 connects Linz with Salzburg, Munich and Vienna, respectively. When you leave A1 at exit Linz/A7, drive on the motorway A7 in direction Freistadt and take exit 15 "Linz-Dornach". Follow the directions to JKU – Universität, to the address Altenberger Straße 69, Science Park 2. You can park in the parking garage, below Science Park.

### Language

The official language of Austria is German, although in Linz a local dialect (namely the “Upper Austrian German” is widely used by locals).

### Shop opening hours

### Smoking areas

Smoking is not allowed in public areas e.g. airports, train stations, universities, shops, restaurants, bars. Smoking at JKU is only allowed outside the university buildings.

### Time Zone

The time zone in Austria in February is CEST – Central European Summer Time = UTC/GMT +1 hour.

### Visa

Participants from the EU, USA, Canada, New Zealand, Japan etc. do not need a visa for travelling to Austria. Participants from e.g. Russian Federation, India, Peoples of China, Argentina, etc. have to apply for a Visa. Please contact the Austrian Embassy or an Austrian Consulate in your country. Please note: It may take you several weeks to several months to apply for and receive your visa. If you need an invitation letter for your VISA application, please contact us.

### Weather an Climate

Austria has a continental climate. In February the medium temperature is around +1°C (34°F), but can drop down to -15°C (+5°F). Precipitation is low in February, mostly snow.
